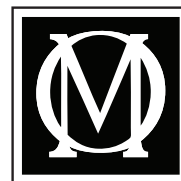

Application for Admission

Application Process

All students are required to pay a non-refundable \$50 application fee and submit transcripts and standardized test scores as listed below:

- First-time freshmen must submit an official, sealed copy of their high school transcripts along with at least one copy of their ACT or SAT scores. If the student did not finish high school, an official copy of the GED with a score of 450 or higher is required.
- Transfers must send official, sealed copies of all college transcripts from each institution the student has attended. Each transcript must be sent directly to O'More from the institution. Students who have accumulated fewer than 60 credit hours must also submit their final high school official transcript (or GED scores, if applicable) as well as at least one copy of the SAT or ACT if the student took either before entering college.

Admission for Degree-Seeking Students

Once all transcripts have been received, the admissions office will promptly notify students if their academic credentials qualify them to proceed further in the admissions process. In O'More's analysis of a student's high school record, only grades in academic core subjects (English, math, science, social sciences, history, and foreign language) will count, along with any art coursework the student has completed, with an extra 0.5 points added to the grade of any honors courses and 0.75 added to the grade in AP classes.

If a student's grades and test scores are high enough, and the application and statement of purpose are satisfactory, O'More will automatically admit the student with no further credentials or work required. However, students who meet the college's minimum academic standards but are not offered automatic acceptance will still be given a chance at admittance. Each student will be asked to either submit a portfolio of original artwork or to complete a department's home exam (a series of design-related projects assigned by the chair of the appropriate department) and to interview with that department chair. For more information on the portfolio and home exam process, students should contact their respective department chairs.

Admission for International Students

O'More College of Design is authorized by federal law to enroll non-immigrant alien students with an M-1 classification. International students must comply with the same application requirements as other students of their educational and age classifications, as well as submit an official copy of a TOEFL score of 500 or higher.

Admission for Non-Degree Seeking Students

Students wishing to take courses without seeking a degree must pay the \$50 application fee and submit official transcripts as required. Non-degree seeking students do not have to meet the normal admissions requirements and may be admitted with the approval of the admissions office and/or the appropriate department chair.

If a non-degree seeking student wishes to become a degree-seeking student, he or she must complete the normal admissions procedures. If admission to a degree program is granted, credits accumulated as a non-degree seeking student will transfer into a degree major.

Admission for Auditing Students

Students wishing to audit a course must follow the application procedures for a non-degree seeking student. Students may audit classes under the following conditions:

- when classroom space is available;
- with the registrar's permission;
- when payment of a fee equal to 50% of the full course tuition is made; and
- when all applicable fees are paid before the first class.
