



Interior Design Admissions Assessment

Students applying for admission to O'More College's Interior Design Program may be asked to complete an Admissions Assessment. The Assessment will involve three assignments followed by an interview with the Department Chair.

The assignments are intended to demonstrate that a prospective student has the creative ability, the work ethic, and a familiarity with design that will be required of incoming students to O'More's Interior Design Program.

Assignments:

1. Look around your community. Identify a building that you find architecturally interesting, and create one or more sketches of that building. Pay close attention to proportions and details.
2. Create an artwork of your choosing—painting, sculpture, rendering, collage, etc.—that represents your best creative and artistic abilities and that is inspired by a particular stylistic period in the history of design. Be prepared to describe your creative process and inspiration.
3. Create a presentation that depicts a particular room (or rooms) for which you imagine the design yourself. The presentation should include a floor plan (a “map” showing the space as if seen from above), images of furnishings, and drawings that describe the space and the contents you would place in it. The room can be of any sort you choose, e.g. a living room in a residence, a dining room in a restaurant, a hotel lobby, a retail space, etc.
