



Portfolio Scholarship Submission Guidelines

Please read the following carefully. Submissions which do not follow these guidelines will be rejected.

What To Submit

Painting, drawing, printmaking

- Original pieces

Sculpture (including ceramics)

- Must be submitted in photo form only

No more than 2 pieces may be represented through photographs. This includes sculpture.

Photo quality should be professional grade so that the work is well represented.

How Many Pieces

Eight to twelve quality pieces

The following will not be accepted:

Craftwork, mosaic, beadwork, collage, furniture, photography, interior design boards, graphic design, computer generated images, fashion design drawings, clothing

Presentation

- Each individual piece must be labeled with your name
- Work on paper or canvas must be flat (not rolled) and placed in a portfolio
- Matting is not required and only suggested if it is done professionally and enhances the work
- All portfolios must be labeled with your name, address, and phone number
- Award notifications will not be given until all scoring is completed by the judges

Deadlines

Fall Applicants – August 1

Spring Applicants – December 1
