



Voter Registration

O'More College seeks to make enrolled students informed and participatory citizens of the United States by making widely available voter registration forms. In addition, the 1998 Higher Education Act requires all post-secondary institutions to make information voter registration information and paperwork available to all students.

Information on Voting

An individual who is registered to vote in their home county of residence and is attending a university or college outside their home of voter record may request an absentee ballot from their County Election Commission office (check with your county election office for deadlines), and vote by absentee ballot. Or the student, if residing in Williamson County, may choose to change their county of residence (and spouse if applicable), and register to vote in Williamson County while attending O'More College of Design (which cancels voter registration in the previous county of residence), and then vote either during the announced early voting period, or on election day.

Individuals may register to vote if they:

- Are a U.S. citizen
- Will be 18 years of age on/or before the next election
- Are a resident of Tennessee
- Have not been convicted of a felony or, if convicted, had voting rights restored by a court order or pardon

Distribution

The voter registration form is to be distributed electronically via email to all enrolled students at O'More College of Design, which will contain a link to a digital copy of the form.

The students should receive this e-mail 3 times a year, a minimum of 120 days before the voter registration deadline for the state of Tennessee.
