This course introduces students to the "sociological imagination," which draws connections between their personal experiences and larger social constructs. Major concepts covered include race, culture, gender, wealth & poverty, the family, and social change movements.

Special emphasis will be paid to ways in which sociological constructs influence design and vice-versa.
